- Whereas:** The existence of collaboration between the major programming organizations of Miami University is severely lacking
- Whereas:** Over-programming, and conflicting events are a recurring problem
- Whereas:** It is in the best interest of the student body, for the major programming organizations to be working together with an intimate knowledge of each others efforts and roles
- Therefore be it resolved:** An ad hoc committee be created (further referred to as “Campus Council”) to mitigate these problems
- Further be it resolved:** The Campus Council shall be composed of the ASG Vice President for Student Services, the IFC President, the Panhellenic President, the President of National Pan-Hellenic Council, the Chair of Program Board, the Chair of the Miami University Student Foundation, the Executive Chair of the Campus Activities Council, and be chaired by the Student Body President
- Further be it resolved:** The Campus Council will meet regularly and establish rules and procedures at the discretion of the members
- Further be it resolved:** The Campus Council meetings will be open to all student organization representatives to attend
- Further be it resolved:** The respective ASG members of the Campus Council give reports to the Student Senate
- Rationale:** A formal committee is necessary to the success of this goal. Although most of the organizations are in relative proximity to each other, little to no effective communication has occurred thus far. All parties are willing and excited to do this.
